

BIBLE Bowl RULES

- 1. Bible Bowls are a form of Bible competition designed for team play.**
The object of this competition is to earn more team points than any other team and, thereby, win the overall competition. Points are earned by winning Bible bowl matches.
- 2. Bible bowl matches will take place at scheduled times in the worship center.** Points are earned by memorizing and quoting designated verses and scripture blocks to one of your team leaders (see next page), and by reading the required 5 chapters of the book of James (up to ten times).
- 3. In order to win the Bible Bowl, everyone on the team must work together.** No individual can win by himself or herself. The number of teams will be determined by our total attendance. The number of people on each team will vary from one team to another. In order to give all teams an equal chance to win, points will be prorated based on the number of people on your team.
- 4. During each Bible Bowl session, we will conduct as many matches as possible in the scheduled time.** Two teams will compete at a time throughout the competition. The teams competing will be called to the front of the worship center and sit opposite one another.

When a question is asked, the first person to stand and be recognized will be given the opportunity to answer the question. If a correct response is given, 1 point will be awarded that team. If an incorrect response is given, everyone will be seated and the opposing team will be given an opportunity to answer the question. Once a person is called upon, they will be given 3 seconds to begin their response. The team with the most correct answers at the end of the match will be declared the winner of that match and 10,000 points will be awarded to the winning team.
